What is Our Purpose?

Presbyterians Pro-Life (PPL) seeks to uphold and set forth the biblical vision of human life and the family in two distinct ways:

- ◆ We CALL the Presbyterian & Reformed family of churches to uphold the sacred value of human life from fertilization to natural death and to reflect Biblical teaching on life and family in their theology, polity, and practice.
- ◆ We provide resources that EQUIP Presbyterian & Reformed churches to encourage faithful discipleship and a biblical worldview regarding the family and the nurture, care, and protection of every innocent human life.

We believe the Scriptures teach that God, who made us in His own image, has forbidden us to shed innocent blood.

PPL is committed to protecting the right to life of every human being from the moment of fertilization to the moment of natural death. In decisions about life and death, the sanctity of life of both mother and child must be respected, and every effort to preserve their lives should be made. We stand against abortion, infanticide, euthanasia, and any other practice which would devalue human life.

PPL is convinced that a return to the Biblical teaching concerning the sacred value of the family is essential to recovering respect for the sacred value of individual human lives. God has ordained the family, the basic social unit of all human institutions, to propagate, protect and nurture human life.

PPL is committed to strengthening the bonds of family love and nurture, and to protecting innocent life.



PPL and Public Policy

As an organization, PPL limits its interest in the secular political debate over life issues to the moral influence of the Church on the culture. We believe the state ought to fulfill its duty to resist evil and preserve the lives of the innocent members of its community. However, we deliberately confine our work and witness to the Church.

We are persuaded that the Church's moral role in the society is a primary influence for good or ill. Therefore, for the sake of the integrity of the Church and for the sake of the culture and the people for whom Christ died, we concentrate our efforts on the demonstration of godliness as pertains to the moral life and voice of the Church.
